At the commissioning of a Parish Safeguarding Officer

This liturgy can replace the intercessions in a service of Holy Communion (in which case the Lord's Prayer as printed below should be omitted) or used in a Service of the Word such as all age worship or Morning Prayer.

It is fitting that the first thing a Parish Safeguarding Officer is asked to do when they are commissioned is to pray for the church, its leaders and those we need to safeguard. The role is not just a bureaucratic function but it is a spiritually demanding ministry of service to the church.

Minister:

N, you have been appointed as Parish Safeguarding Officer in this [church / parish / benefice / ...].

We welcome your willingness to serve the church as Parish Safeguarding Officer. Hold before us always the need to be faithful to God's love. I now invite you to lead us in prayer, praying especially for the safe keeping and well-being of all.

Parish Safeguarding Officer:

Let us pray. Lord God we come together to acknowledge your deep and everlasting love for each and every one of us. We come to you this day, recognizing the challenges before us, the brokenness of ourselves and brokenness of our world.

Lord, come to bless us, All: and make us more like Jesus

God you know that our leaders of [Scouts, Guides, Sunday clubs, youth group etc] have agreed to take on special responsibilities. Keep them vigilant, but with your loving heart and abundant grace. Help them and us to see with your

eyes the struggles of those around us.

Lord, come to bless us, All: and make us more like Jesus Creator God, you set us among family and friends and neighbours. Here we see who our true selves are often poorly reflecting the depth of your love. Protect us, guard us and guide us in our homes, in our work and our play.

Lord, come to bless us, All: and make us more like Jesus

Lord God, you know how we carry pain, physically, emotionally and mentally. You know how deeply we need your healing love, mercy and forgiveness to dispel the darkness. Help us to be honest with ourselves so that we can let your love work.

Bring wholeness, healing and lightness of spirit into all our lives.

We hold before you those who need your healing touch at this time..... (silence)
