The PCC (Parochial Church Council) of St Mary Magdalene Church Ickleton, wishes to appoint a consultant to fulfil the monitoring and evaluation element of the National Lottery Heritage Fund supported project, entitled, “Looking Up and Out: conserving Ickleton’s wall paintings and building inclusive connections”.

Our village project includes a programme of repairs to the church building, (which will be led by the architect), and conservation of our outstanding medieval wall paintings, along with community outreach and activities to grow the volunteer support base for the church and engage a wider range of people in local heritage.

The Evaluation consultant will work closely with the local project task group, which includes the Vicar, Churchwarden, Architect, Wall painting Conservator, SEND Specialist Heritage Consultant and key volunteers

We are looking for someone with experience of delivering projects supported by The National Lottery Heritage Fund and of working with a wide variety of people, including school-aged children.

This is predominantly a home-working post, but time will be spent at the church and other local project sites as required and may involve occasional weekend and evening work. Working hours will be agreed based on requirements of the post and flexible in line with development of the project.
