

Wildlife Sanctuary

This burial ground is a sanctuary for wildlife. Because of changes in the countryside, wildflower meadows are now rare in Cambridgeshire, and churchyards and cemeteries are some of the last remnants of this kind of habitat.

This burial ground is looked after in a way that is sympathetic to conservation. So you will see parts of the grassland left uncut at certain times of the year to allow the plants to flower and seed. The grass is then cut and raked off.
