FOR THE PROSE/ART: This could include written or artwork either focussed on MU or with a special meaning relating to faith, family, friendship and fellowship, or God's world and creation: e.g. poems, prayers, a short piece about what MU means to you, a hymn/song that is special. If you are creative it could be a drawing/painting that you have done.

ENTRY RULES. ANY QUERIES, PLEASE CONTACT DEBBIE TYE.

1. Up to 5 entries can be submitted across both categories.
2. Photos can be taken on a camera, phone, or iPad/tablet, and can be any size or format (but images should be no larger than 2MB), and sent electronically or by post. Large files may need to be emailed separately. Permission must be obtained from any people featured in the pictures.
3. Written items can be sent by email, in a word document or PDF. Artwork can be posted, hand-delivered or photographed.
4. Receipt will be acknowledged. If you haven't heard within 2 days of emailing your photos, email again without the attachments.
5. All submitted photos/items would be used at Trustees discretion for display, publicity and fundraising purposes.
