NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Works of repair and maintenance at Mill Road cemetery, namely:
Inspection, stabilisation, repair and cleaning of monuments and kerbs, and removal of small pieces of unidentifiable monuments that present a hazard to cemetery users;
Replacement of eroded or lost monuments with new monuments;
Maintenance and like for like repairs to cemetery walls, gates and railings using matching materials and conservation techniques;
Maintenance of trees, including re-pollarding the limes in the Avenue, crown reduction and lifting and general pruning; Removal of self-set saplings; planting of new and replacement trees in keeping with the original coniferous planting of the cemetery; Emergency tree works, including felling where there is an immediate threat to the public. All tree works subject to approval from the City Council Trees Officer.
Temporary installation of information signage and the replacement of existing permanent signage and noticeboards; Temporary installation of artworks as part of an exhibition;
Closure or elimination of unofficial footpaths.
